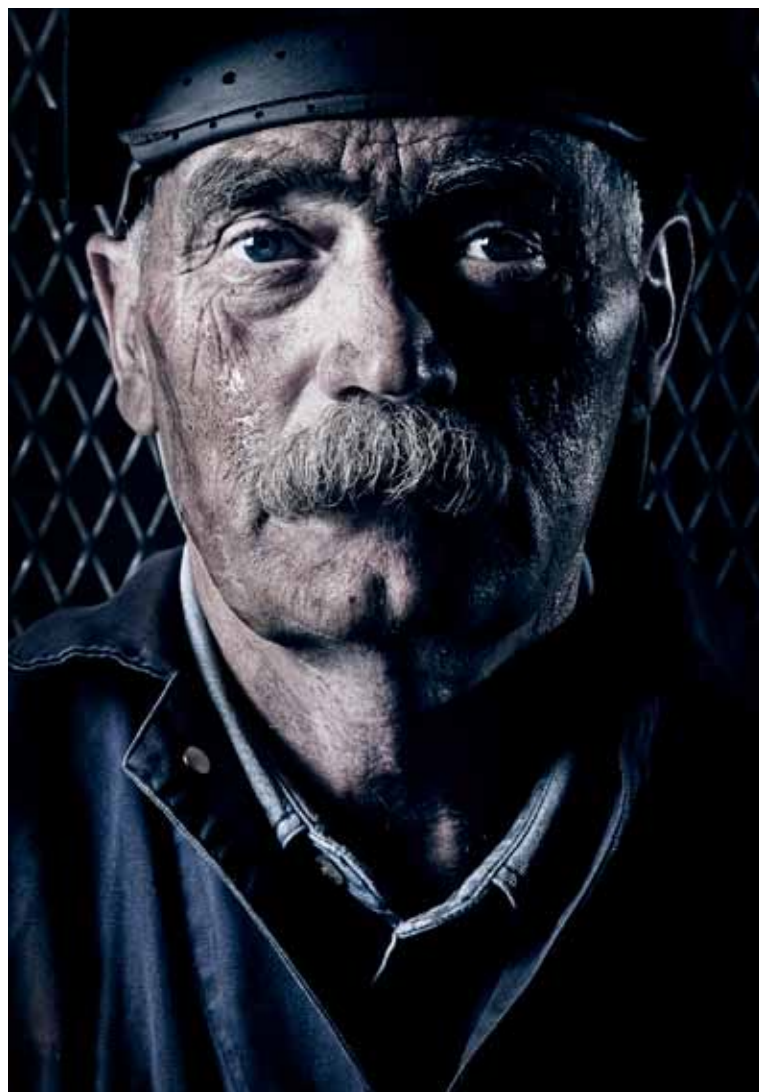

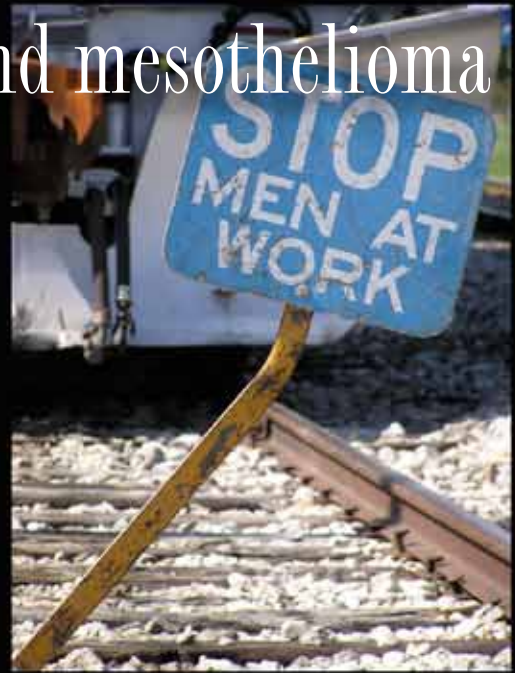

The connection—jobs and mesothelioma

While mesothelioma is a very rare type of cancer, it is always linked to asbestos exposure. And, almost always, that exposure occurred on certain job sites. Many mesothelioma cases involve people who worked in any of the following occupations at sometime in their lives, or who lived with those who worked at these occupations:

Paper mills
Refineries
Power plants
Pipefitters
Manufacturing plants
Laborers

Chemical plants
Boilermakers
Electricians
Shipyards
Insulators



What is mesothelioma?

You may have heard about mesothelioma. It is pronounced like this: meezo-thee-lee-oh-ma.



This is a serious type of cancer that is directly linked to asbestos exposure. Often, the disease develops in the lungs. Sometimes, doctors call it lung cancer. Mesothelioma is a rare disease that most often strikes people who are older than 50. However, younger people—even those in their 30s

and 40s—can be diagnosed with it. Not everyone exposed to asbestos develops mesothelioma. Doctors don't know why some get the disease while others don't. Usually, it is diagnosed MANY years after someone is exposed to asbestos. It is common for doctors to find the disease in someone 30, 40 and even 50 years after they were exposed.



Asbestos Facts

It's hard to believe that tiny asbestos fibers, often so small that they couldn't be seen by the naked eye, could cause horrible diseases like mesothelioma and lung cancer. But it's true. And many of the companies and industries that made asbestos KNEW it decades ago. Unfortunately, that didn't stop them from making products containing asbestos.

Diseases like lung cancer and mesothelioma might not even show up for many years after exposure. We help people who are sick now because many years ago they worked where asbestos was present.

Sometimes, we represent family members who are sick

with mesothelioma and lung cancer. They never worked around asbestos themselves, but they were exposed to it when someone in their home wore work clothes home that had asbestos fibers on them. We have represented women who were homemakers and who developed asbestos-related

diseases because they washed their husbands' clothes that were covered in tiny asbestos particles. Family members may receive large cash settlements because of their exposure to asbestos. Please call us to find out more.
